COUNCIL AWARDS BID for new aerial unit —The Plattsmouth City Council
accepted the recommendation from fire chief Mike Wilson and a fire
department committee to purchase a Pierce firetruck. The cost is \$2.31
million. After the discount for prepayment at contract signing and the
down payment are applied, the remainder is \$1.81 million.
The city council passed an ordinance recently that authorized the issuance
of public safety tax anticipation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$2.4
million. At last night's meeting, those bonds were set to reflect the \$1.81
million loan.
The city received aerial truck bids from two vendors. In the written
committee recommendation, Wilson stated even though the bid from
Pierce was slightly more expensive, it is believed the extra cost is more
than made up for in craftsmanship and quality of the product as evidenced
by past experience with Pierce apparatus.
The build and delivery time for the new unit is projected at four years.

DRIVER IN WEEKEND PURSUIT IDENTIFIED — The incident started at 6:30
Saturday night. A blue sports bike was clocked going 96 mph in a 60-mph
zone on Highway 75 south of Plattsmouth. There was a pursuit through
town which ended with the bike crashing at the city/county line on the
east side of Plattsmouth. According to reports from the Cass County
Sheriff's Office, the driver lost control, veered off the road and collided
with a tree. 28-year-old Anthony Warner of Plattsmouth sustained several
injuries and was transported to the trauma center.
Warner's driving privileges were revoked in Nebraska. The sheriff's office,
"while no charges are filed at the time they are currently expected pending
further investigation and analysis of evidence gathered at the scene and
the hospital."

THE COUNTY JAIL INMATE with the longest current length of incarceration
time will likely remain there until his trial date this coming June or a plea
agreement is reached -- 58-year-old Michael L. Brueckner of Eagle is in
Cass County Jail. Bond is \$500,000. He went before the judge yesterday
with his attorney, Mike Ziskey, asking for a bond reduction.
Brueckner has been held in county jail on the same bond amount since
October 2022.
Ziskey said the bond is "extremely high and unwarranted." He asked that
bond be reduced to "something more manageable" for the Brueckner
family and suggested \$50,000 with pretrial release conditions in place.
Ziskey said the family would benefit from Michael Brueckner going back to
work in his construction business.
Cass County Attorney Chris Perrone objected. Perrone recounted the
alleged events of October 6th, 2022. A Cass County sheriff's deputy had
responded to a domestic disturbance call that night at the Brueckner
residence in Eagle. Brueckner got into his vehicle, backed up and the
vehicle struck the deputy. Brueckner then drove to Kansas and was
arrested there after Taser deployment by Kansas law enforcement.
Perrone noted that the delays in the trial process were the result of
actions from the defendant's side. Three other attorneys were either
dismissed by Brueckner or withdrew from the case over the last 18
months.
Cass County District Court Judge Micheal A. Smith left the bond at
\$500,000. He said that if the defense request was granted, "I would have
concerns about him showing up for trial."
Brueckner has entered not guilty pleas to four felonies and one
misdemeanor. The state has requested habitual criminal enhancers on the
felonies.

REWARD OFFERED IN SIGN VANDALISM incidents — The Alan Miller for
Cass County Commissioner Committee reported five large campaign signs
were damaged and one is missing. It is believed the vandalism occurred
sometime Sunday night. The committee is offering a \$1,000 reward for
any information that leads to the arrest and conviction of individuals
responsible for the damage.
A sheriff's report was filed. Suspect information can be given through
sheriff's office channels.
